Color-Code Your Safety!



Use color to make safety more visible, memorable and intuitive:
use colored dots, ribbons, tape, markers, paint, paper, rugs, picture frames, etc.

RED: to alert people to serious threats. *For example: dangerous chemicals.*

YELLOW: to urge extra caution and care. *For example: slippery/wet floors; steep inclines.*

GREEN: to remind people of safety-related resources. *For example: supplies (food, first aid kits or defibrilators) or places (Rally Points or safe places to Drop, Cover and Hold On).*
